Programmes

- v. To prepare State of the art reports on land and water resources of India

Conditions

- i. The income and property of the Society shall be used solely towards the promotion of the objectives of the Society as set forth in the Memorandum of Association and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly, to the members of the Society.
- ii. No member of the Government Body of the society, shall be appointed to any salaried office of the Society, or any office of the Society paid by fees, that no remuneration shall be given by the Society to any member of such Government Body except repayment of out of pocket expenses and interest on money lent or rent for premises/demises to the Society.
- iii. The Society by its constitution is required to apply its profits, if any, or other income in promoting its objectives.
- iv. If upon the winding up or dissolution of the society there remains after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the society, but shall be given or transferred to some other Institution having objects similar to the objects of the society to be determined by the members of the society at or before the time of dissolution.

CONSTITUTION (RULES AND REGULATIONS) OF THE SOCIETY

1. The Society shall be called the *Indian Society of Soil Salinity and Water Quality (ISSWQ)*

2. Whereas it is now known that health and strength of India's natural resources, i.e., land and water is degrading at an accelerated pace, productive resources are being diverted from agricultural to other sectors jeopardizing the production and productivity of food grains, fiber, fodder, fuel wood, timber and other useful biomass. Increased production of these items hinges upon the best use of degraded land and water resources of India. Moreover the appropriate use of these resources in general and salt-affected soils and poor quality waters in particular would help to preserve the human environment

Time has come to highlight this situation and to generate awareness in the Public, Central and State Governments, NGOs and other stakeholders so that concerted efforts could be made to ameliorate these degraded resources through various programmes jointly in an action mode.

To take forward the process of implementing land and water reclamation and conservation technologies, generating awareness about the state of the national soil and water resources and initiating such actions/programmes that would reverse land and water degradation processes and building a strong natural resource base for Indian wastelands and water including capacity building shall be the aim of the *Indian Society of Soil Salinity and Poor Quality*.

Objectives

3. The objectives of the Society shall be:

- v. To facilitate in survey of natural resources of India with the aim to generate databases and suggest preventive and reclamation strategies
- vi. To transfer knowledge and technologies related to soil salinity and water quality
- vii. Human Resource Development and capacity building of stakeholders in the area of soil salinity, water quality and natural resource management
- viii. To facilitate in policy planning processes for the upliftment of civil communities

Programmes

4. To achieve these aims and objectives, the Society shall:

- vi. Publish a biannual journal, bulletins, books and bring out special issues of the journal.
- vii. Organize Symposia/Workshops/Conferences, popular lectures, excursions and exhibitions.
- viii. Form Regional Chapters of the Society in different parts of India.
- ix. To undertake consultancy and training programmes in the relevant fields, and collaborate, wherever necessary with other Voluntary Agencies and Non-Government Organizations (NGOs).
- x. To prepare State of the art reports on land and water resources of India

5. **The Society shall consist of**

(a) *Patron(s)*: No more than 5 patrons would be in office at any time

(b) *Honorary Members*: No more than 10 honorary members would be nominated to the society by the executive.

(c) *Fellows*: The executive committee would elect/select five fellows from amongst the founder members and then 2 fellows every year for which the members may apply on a prescribed form with nominations from the existing fellows of the Society. All life members who would sign the initial memorandum and pay the fees of the life

member before the prescribed date for this purpose would be treated as founder members.

- (d) *Annual Members*: Any person willing to promote the aims and objectives of the Society within the framework of its constitution after contributing annual fees of Rs. 250 per annum and Rs. 50 as admission fees or as fixed from time to time by the executive council. Members from foreign countries would pay in INR equivalent to US \$50.
- (e) *Life Members*: Individuals who contribute a lump sum amount of Rs. 2000.00 plus an initial admission fee of Rs. 50 or as fixed by the Executive Council from time to time. Members from foreign countries would pay in INR equivalent to US \$250.
- (f) *Associates members*: Students and research fellows could become the associate members upon payment of half the fees of annual members.
- (g) *Institutional Members*: Institutions/organizations contributing Rs. 2500.00 per annum or a lump sum of Rs. 20, 000.00 (or as fixed by the Executive Council from time to time). On payment of lump sum fees as above, the organization would become the member of the society for a period of 30 years from the date of receipt.

6. Members (of all categories except patron and honorary members) shall be entitled to the following privileges:

- i. To be present and vote in all general meetings (except patron/ honorary members).
- ii. To propose candidates for membership (except patron/ honorary members).
- iii. To have personal access to the library and general meetings.
- iv. To receive the journals of the Society.
- v. To fill any office of the Society on being duly elected thereto (except patron/ honorary members).

7. Members of all categories shall pay such admission fee and an annual subscription as decided by the Executive Council from time to time. The subscription shall be valid for the financial year (1st April to 31st March) provided that any member may pay his life subscription with the option of paying in two installments.

8. The affairs of the Society shall be managed by an Executive Council consisting of the following:

- (a) President
- (b) Vice-Presidents (2)
- (c) General Secretary
- (d) Joint Secretary
- (e) Treasurer
- (f) Chief Editor
- (g) Councilors (8)

9. **Executive Committee**

- i. The first executive would be nominated by the President while later on the General Body will elect the Executive Committee except the President of the Society.
- ii. The Executive Committee will be appointed for a duration of 3 financial years. Later on the executive would be elected for a period of 2 years.
- iii. The Executive Committee shall meet at least 2 times a year. At least one-third members of the executive be present for the quorum. Minutes of the meeting shall be maintained and open to the members.
- iv. The Executive Committee is obliged to prepare the budget and the financial statement. It shall present these to the General Body for approval. After approval of the financial statement, the original of the balance sheet will be filed with the district Registrar within twenty-one days of the General Body

meeting with the signatures of the members of the Executive Committee including the Treasurer.

- v. The Executive Committee has the authority to employ/ terminate the services of the employees of the Society.

10. President

- i. The President shall preside over the General Body and the Executive committee. In his absence, the Vice-President will act as president. In the absence of both, senior most member of the Executive Committee can preside over the meetings.
- ii. All the documents have to be signed by the President and the Secretary.
- iii. (3) All assets of the society are in the name of the President and the Secretary as joint owners. All bank accounts are operated as per item .
- iv. President of the society would handle all legal cases arising on behalf of the Society.

11. Vice President

In the absence of the President, the senior most Vice-President will discharge his duties. He would also discharge any other duties assigned by the president.

12. General Secretary

- i. The General-secretary shall convene the General Body and Executive Committee meetings. The Secretary has to carry out the day-to-day activities of the Society, conforming to the directives of the President/Executive committee.
- ii. The Secretary will submit the minutes of the annual meeting to the General Body with the approval of the Executive committee. He should keep all the minutes of meetings and records.
- iii. All assets of the Society are in the name of the President and the Secretary as joint owners. All bank accounts are operated jointly.
- iv. The Secretary should deposit all amounts exceeding Rs. 1000, or as decided by the General Body, into the bank account. Amounts less than this should be entrusted to the Treasurer.
- v. All documents have to be signed by the President and the General Secretary.

11. Treasurer

The Treasurer will take care of all money provided to him/her by the General Secretary and will provide money to the Secretary on his request. The Treasurer has to keep the accounts up-to-date and submit these to the secretary from time to time.

13. Joint Secretary

He will support the General Secretary in the discharge of duties. In the absence of the General Secretary, he will discharge the functions of General Secretary.

14. Councilors

Initially four councilors would be nominated and as the society expands 4 more councilors would be nominated in due course of time. They will help the executive in the discharge of duties.

- 15. Director CSSRI would be the ex-officio president of the Society provided he is/becomes the life member of the Society.

- 16. Incumbents of the four posts, viz. (i) General Secretary, (ii) one Vice-President (iii) Jt. Secretary and (iv) Treasurer shall be filled in by persons residing at the Society's headquarters.

17. The post of the Chief Editor shall be filled by nomination of the incumbent by the President of the Society. The President on the recommendations of the Chief Editor would nominate the editorial board of the Journal.
18. In case of vacancy of the President's post (for whatever reason), Senior Vice-President shall become the President. Other vacancies in the Executive Council shall be filled in by the Executive Council itself.
19. The Executive Council shall be entitled to nominate additional members for any specific purpose or for filling vacancies in the Council.
20. Chairpersons of the Chapters of the Society shall be ex-officio Regional Members of the Society.
21. The Executive Council and all the office bearers, except the President and the Chief Editor, shall be elected directly by the General Body during its meeting and shall hold office for a period of 3 financial years. However, the Existing Executive Council shall continue to function with full powers till the next one is duly elected and takes charge. The Chief Editor's post will be filled in as provided in Section 15.
22. (a) There shall be an Annual Budget of the Society which shall be adopted by the Executive Council for the financial year from 1st April to 31st March.
(b) The funds of the Society shall be deposited in a Bank and shall be operated jointly by two signatures of:
 - (i) One: President
 - (ii) Two: Secretary-General or Treasurer
(c) The President, Vice-President and Secretary-General jointly may spend up to Rs. 5000.00 per month under their own powers beyond which they shall seek the prior approval of the Executive Council.

(d) A statement of monthly accounts shall be presented to the meetings of the Executive Council.

(e) The accounts of the Society shall be audited every year by the AFACO of CSSRI Karnal or by a Registered Chartered Accountant.

(f) The balance sheet shall be approved by the Executive Council and shall be included in the Annual Report of the Society to be placed before the General Body meeting or to be circulated to members if it is not possible to hold such a meeting every year.
23. The Headquarters of the Society would be CSSRI, Karnal. Appropriate space/facilities for Headquarters of the Society would be made available by the Director, CSSRI, Karnal.
24. A code of professional ethics shall be prescribed by the Society, which shall govern all categories of Members.
25. Only the General Body Meeting would have powers to amend this constitution. One-third of the membership should be present to complete the quorum and at least 50 % of those present should support the amendment.
26. The Society shall not be dissolved except by a postal ballot in which three-fourth of the total number of valid Members with voting rights vote for such dissolution.

27. Funds and Profits

Funds and income of the Society would be used for achieving the objectives of the Society and would not be divided among the individual members. The functioning of the Society will be on a no-loss no-profit basis, and any balance obtained during the financial year shall be carried over to the next financial year.
